Worship Notes – The original title of *Blest Be the Tie That Binds* was *Brotherly Love* and was written by John Fawcett, author of one hundred sixty-six hymns. Fawcett (1740-1817) was born in Lidget Green, Yorkshire, and at sixteen was converted to Christianity through the preaching of George Whitefield. He joined the Methodists but a few years later became a Baptist. At 25, he was ordained a Baptist pastor to the Wainsgate Baptist Church in West Yorkshire.

At age 32, he accepted a call to another church. His bags were packed and loaded on the wagon as he preached his farewell sermon. However, the members' tears and his wife's sadness as well as his own led him to give the order to unpack. It was this event that inspired the words to this hymn. He served at Wainsgate for the rest of his life.
