Worship Notes – The original title of *Blest Be the Tie That Binds* was *Brotherly Love* and was written by John Fawcett, author of one hundred sixty-six hymns. Fawcett (1740-1817) was born in Lidget Green, Yorkshire, and at sixteen was converted to Christianity through the preaching of George Whitefield. He joined the Methodists but a few years later became a Baptist. At 25, he was ordained a Baptist pastor to the Wainsgate Baptist Church in West Yorkshire.

At age 32, he accepted a call to another church. His bags were packed and loaded on the wagon as he preached his farewell sermon. However, the members' tears and his wife's sadness as well as his own led him to give the order to unpack. It was this event that inspired the words to this hymn. He served at Wainsgate for the rest of his life.

ANNUAL FINANCIAL AUDIT – The church has just completed an annual financial review by Dale Eckler of Eckler Consulting. Mr. Eckler conducted a thorough review of over 580 deposits and disbursements and "found no evidence that funds had been misused." Mr. Eckler did include several recommendations on how FPC could improve our money-handling practices to better protect funds and our people. The treasurer and the Finance Committee have already begun looking at how we might implement these recommendations. This audit is one that is required by the denomination. A copy of the full report is in the church office and is available for anyone to review.
