WORSHIP NOTES – The text to the hymn, *Come, Thou Fount of Every Blessing*, was written by Robert Robinson (1735-1790). Robinson was born in Norfolk, England, and became a barber. After attending an evangelistic service of George Whitefield's, he began to work for the evangelical revival. In 1758, Robinson became a minister of the Chapel at Mildenhall, Norfolk. He then became pastor of the Baptist Church in Cambridge. Although he had no formal education, he learned French and Latin and wrote several books, including a History of the Baptists. He died in Birmingham.
